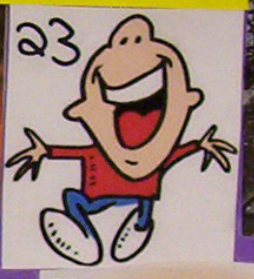
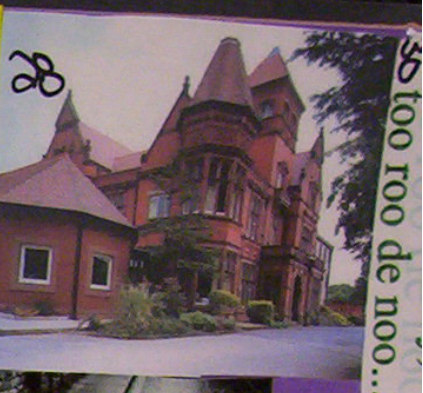

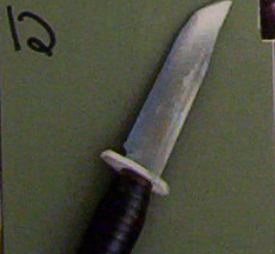

## Jade Green Collage

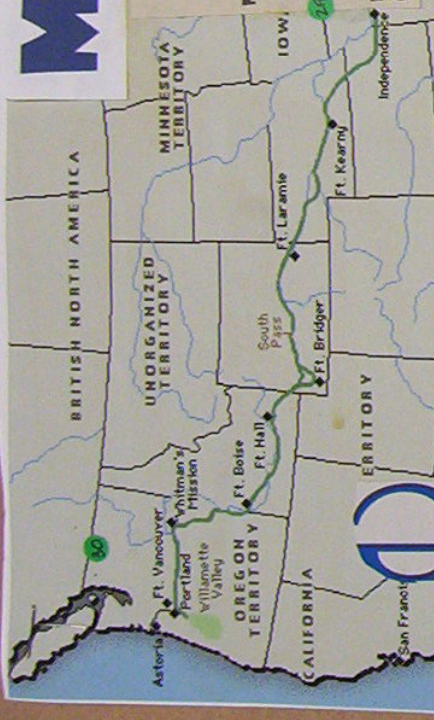
- 1.) People walking – I have a picture of people walking because the hand of Jade Green could be seen walking around the house.

11. Monkey- Mr. Pignati liked the monkeys the best out of all the zoo animals. He even named one of the monkeys and died in front of the monkey's cage.

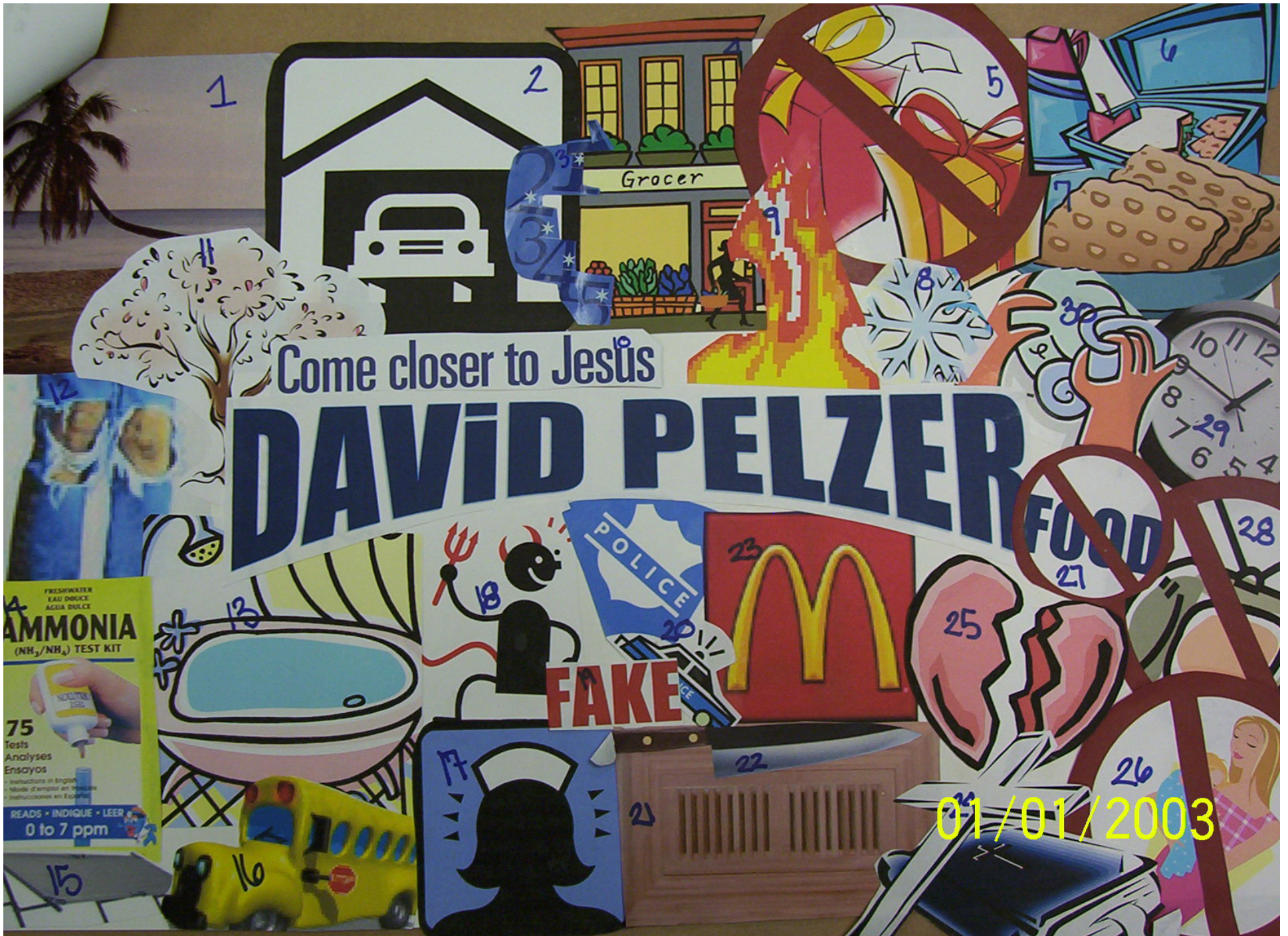
12. Eye- when Lorraine met John she first noticed his beautiful eyes.
