

# Most common Book Report Project mistakes

- Direction 5 – Character's name MUST be on the front, AND it does NOT count as a picture
- Direction 10 – Is there a movie/tv show about your book? You can NOT use ANY picture that comes from movie or show. Or any pictures that are DIRECTLY taken from the book.
- Book Cover – This does NOT count as a picture
- Having lots of UNUSED/BLANK space on the poster. Use the WHOLE poster up with pics.
- Explanations – TWO or MORE sentences explaining how the picture connects to the book. If your explanation is just telling me what the picture is, then it does NOT count.
- Starting EVERY explanation with the same phrase is annoying and costs points. Do NOT start with "I chose this because" or "This is Jonny doing" every time. Just explain the picture without the repeated beginning phrase.
- Writing the explanations in PENCIL will automatically drop you a letter grade.

My goal is to give you a perfect score...unless you convince me that you shouldn't have one.

How do you do that? By not following the basic directions.

Follow the directions and put effort into it = an A+ for me.
