

“OUTSIDERS HW 2” (CHAPS 5 - 8)

The answers to this should be written in your notebook using the title listed above and today's date.

Choose just one of the following options for your homework. Label which option you choose. Each **EXTRA** option you choose to does gain you **THREE B POINTS**. Doing all 12 questions in option 1 earns one extra B point.

OPTION ONE: ANSWER THE QUESTIONS

Answer any TEN of the following TWELVE questions using **complete sentences**.

1. Describe the relationship between Johnny and mother.
2. Describe why Randy is considering backing out of the big Rumble.
3. What did Johnny and Ponyboy eat to survive while at the church?
4. What message is the sunset poem supposed to teach us about life?
5. How do the boys prevent the police from recognizing them while in hiding?
6. How is Cherry planning on helping the Greasers after Bob died?
7. Why does Johnny decide to turn himself in?
8. Using the poem, what is the best guess as to what Dally's "gold" would be?
9. What happens to Dally and Johnny after the fire?
10. Why are the greasers considered to be heroes?
11. Why does Cherry refuse to visit Johnny while he is in the hospital?
12. While in the hospital, why does Dally want Twobit's knife?

OPTION TWO: ALPHABET PHRASE HW

You may ONLY cover CHAPTERS 5-8 of the OUTSIDERS.

Using the letters **G-R-E-A-S-E-R--S-O-C**, come up with TEN sentences either describing the story or giving a fact about it. Each sentence must begin with one of the letters from the above phrase, and once a letter is taken in the phrase, it can't be used again. There should be a total of TEN sentences.

Each phrase must have no **FEWER** than 6 words, and **NO MORE** than 15 words.

OPTION THREE: BACKGROUND & CONFUSED

You may ONLY cover CHAPTERS 5-8 of the OUTSIDERS.

You will do **TEN Background Knowledge OR Confused statements**.

Background Knowledge statements are where you connect things going on in the short story to things you already know about in life. This is a way to give meaning to stuff you read in the poem.

Confused statements are when you write down things in the short story that confuse you or give you trouble. You can have any combination of these two statements for this option as long as your total is ten.

Label each statement as either a [BK] background or [C] confused statement **AND number them**.

OPTION FOUR: TAPE IN YOUR QUIZ

If you score a 23 or higher on the Outsiders quiz #2, then you may choose to just tape that quiz in to your notebook on the Outsiders HW 2 page instead of answering questions. Use at least 4 pieces of **clear** tape and the tape must be on the **four corners**. You may **NOT** use glue, duct tape or any other adhesive. You must have your **OWN** tape for this and be a member of the **TAPE CLUB**.

If you choose this option and forget to do it by the due date, then the homework is considered late and this option becomes **VOID**.
