

“PRINCESS BRIDE #1”

(INTRO & CHAPS 1-4)

The answers to this should be **written in your notebook** using the title listed above and today's date.

Choose just one of the following options for your homework. Label which option you choose. Each **EXTRA** option you choose to does gain you **THREE B POINTS**. Doing all 12 questions in option 1 earns one extra B point.

Once your homework is LATE (not turned in on the due date), then you can ONLY choose OPTION ONE.

OPTION ONE: ANSWER THE QUESTIONS

Answer the following questions using **complete sentences**.

1. How does the intro begin and how does that connect to the book?
2. How does Goldman first encounter The Princess Bride?
3. Describe Goldman's son?
4. Why does Goldman get him the birthday present he does? How does the son feel about that present?
5. Who is Sandy? What role does she play in the story?
6. What evidence is there in the book to demonstrate how Westley and Buttercup feel about each other?
7. Why does the Prince have the Zoo of Death?
8. Why does the Prince demand Princess Noreena leave?
9. Why does Buttercup originally refuse to marry the Prince? How does he convince her?
10. Why does Goldman cut out the entire Chapter Four from the original book?

OPTION TWO: ALPHABET PHRASE HW

Using the word **B – U – T – T – E – R – C – U – P** come up with nine sentences either describing the story or giving a fact about the story. Each sentence must begin with one of the letters from the above phrase, and once a letter is taken in the phrase, it can't be used again. There should be a total of nine sentences.

Each phrase must have no FEWER than 6 words, and NO MORE than 15 words

You may **ONLY** cover the **Intro through the end of Chapter FOUR** of the PRINCESS BRIDE.

OPTION THREE: BACKGROUND & CONFUSED

You will do **TEN** Background Knowledge OR Confused statements.

Background Knowledge statements are where you connect things going on in the book to things you already know about in life. This is a way to give meaning to stuff you read in the story. **Confused** statements are when you write down things in the book that confuse you or give you trouble. You can have any combination of these two statements for this option as long as your total is ten.

List both the page # and chapter # of where the statement occurs so that you can find it later.

Label each statement as either a [BK] background or [C] confused statement **AND** number them.

OPTION FOUR: TAPE IN YOUR QUIZ

If you score a 23 or higher on the Princess Quiz, then you may choose to just tape that quiz in to your notebook on the Homework page instead of answering questions. Use at least 4 pieces of **clear** tape and the tape must be on the four corners. You may **NOT** use **glue, duct tape or any other adhesive**.

You MUST have the ROLL of tape WITH you IN CLASS for this to count. And your NAME must be written on the roll.

If you choose this option and forget to do it by the due date, then the homework is considered late and this option becomes VOID.
