- Please read ALL the directions carefully before beginning, you will need to plan out how to best complete this assignment.
- Follow all directions word for word. The directions are specific and detailed.
- All work must be done in pen. I don't like pencil.
- Put ALL work on this hand out; nothing should be written on a separate sheet.
- Write your first, middle and last name and birthday (month/day/year) on the other side of this paper where it says NAME
- Make sure your class period is written after your name on the other side of this paper.
- Put a 5-pointed star around your name on the other side if you had an A in English on any report card last year.
- Find where it says #1 and write an EIGHT-word sentence there.
- Make sure the sentence tells me about one of your pets (or another animal)
- Make sure you use the pet's name in the sentence.
- Have your pet doing something active in the sentence
- Make sure you wrote the date under your name, not next to it.
- When you write the date under your name, make sure you wrote out the month (ex: August).
- Underline the verbs in the sentence you wrote.
- Circle all the nouns in your sentence.
- Find where it says #2 and draw a small picture of the animal from sentence #1.
- Make sure the picture is in color.
- Draw a small picture of you standing next to your animal.
- Draw a picture of your family standing next to you.

- Only use stick figures for the drawings.
- Make sure you write each person's name so I know who your family members are.
- Do not use markers or crayons to color your people or animal. Use colored pencils or pens.
- Make sure you draw your family members in a row from oldest (left) to the youngest (right).
- Find where is says #3 and list four characters from your favorite book (or any book).
- Do not list more than 2 males or more than 2 females.
- Do not list a person that is related to anybody else on your list.
- Do not list more than one child (person under 18 years of age).
- Please make a note of the fact that this assignment is due MONDAY.
- The assignment will be worth between 5 and 20 points.
- You won't know if it is worth blowing off and not doing until you turn it in.
- Think about how it might be worth basically nothing or it might be worth more than any other assignment.
- 33. Don't forget the other homework you have to do.
- Make sure you list both the first and last names of the characters from the book in part #3.
- Do not list more than one person with a last name that begins with the same letter as someone else.
- Draw a smiley @ face next to your favorite character in your list. Draw a frowny @ face next to your least favorite character on your list.
- Circle the character in your list that you think was the closest to being a Main Character.
- Underline any characters you have not put a mark next to yet.
- You may not use anyone named Tom or Bob as a choice on your list.
- Find where is says #4 and list five different adjectives that you think describe Mr. Broviak.
- None of your adjectives may be repeated; Each must be a different word meaning a different thing.
- Put a smiley @ face next to each positive word.
- Put a frowny @ face next to each negative word.
- Losing this paper or not turning it in is the same grade as doing the whole thing wrong.
- Only follow the directions on line five of this paper. Do not follow any other directions.
- This assignment will allow me to figure out how well you follow directions.
- The ONLY directions you have to follow are direction numbers three, five and this one. I hope you understand that.
- Your 7-letter adjective may not have the letter A in it anywhere.
- None of your adjectives may begin with a vowel.
- Circle the adjective that you think represents me the most.
- Underline the adjective that you think has the least to do with me. You must have more positive adjectives listed than negative ones.
- Find where it says #5 and write a four-line poem describing how you feel about this assignment
- Your poem may either be positive or negative.
- You must have at least five adjectives and six nouns in your poem.
- You should have exactly ten words in each line of your poem.
- Draw a circle around all words in your poem that rhyme with the word "READ". Reading the directions is very important to doing this assignment correctly.
- Make sure your poem has at least four words that rhyme with each other in it.
- You must use at least two different words that rhyme with the word "DIRECTIONS" in your poem.
- Underline your four rhyming words.
- Make sure the star around your name has at least two points going upwards and one going down.
- The poem is the last thing you have to do for this assignment
- Don't use the word "the" anywhere in your poem.
- Give your poem a title.
- The title must have the name of an object in it somewhere.
